

WANDSWORTH COMMUNITY MOURN THE LOSS OF LOVED ONES KILLED IN TERRORIST ATTACKS IN PAKISTAN

Another well known and respected member of Southfield, Dr Mujib ul Haq Khan who has a practice in Granville Road lost his nephew Nasir Mahmood Khan. Dr Khan painfully recounted that Nasir was killed in the attack while saving the lives of many others. Dr Khan said, "eyewitnesses relate that when a grenade was hurled in to the congregation by the terrorists, Nasir got hold of the grenade and attempted to throw it back. The grenade exploded in Nasir's hand and he was killed taking the full impact of the explosion. Through his brave efforts Nasir saved the lives of many while sacrificing his own. Whenever visiting Lahore my wife and I stayed with Nasir's family. He always took great care of us. We will miss him very much." Dr Khan further said that another nephew of his Saleem-Ul-Haq Khan was also at the mosque at the time of the attack.
